Oral presentations must be made by an author from the same mining site where the study was carried out. Presenters who wish to participate in this module must submit their final abstract by 3 August 2012.

The conference technical programme will include both oral and poster presentations. Simultaneous English-Spanish-Portuguese interpretation will be available in all sessions so that presentations may be made in any of the three languages.
